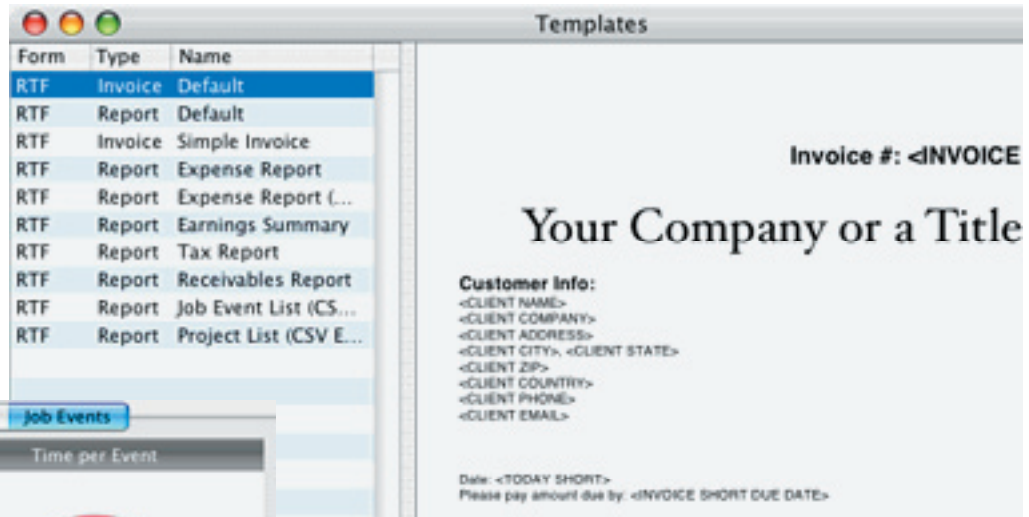




Flat Rate, Quantity, Timed, Mileage, and Payment'; Enter the amount of time spent doing the job/work for that project; Set the Tax rates (there are two separate tax rate fields that can be set); and set whether there is a "Markup" percentage.

iBiz has added features that make it very useful:

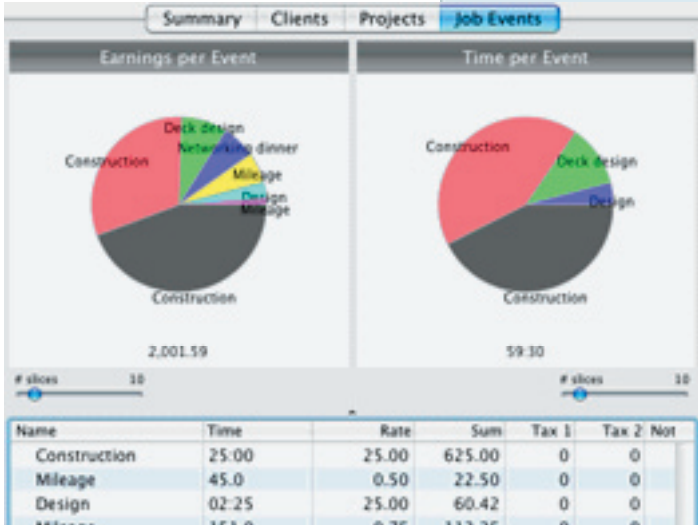
- iBiz is integrated with iCal and Apple's Address book so you can set due dates in iCal or have iBiz automatically added a client's address to an invoice. This

releases you of the tedious task of retyping this information every time you create an invoice for your client.

- If you are very successful and have many clients, iBiz let you filter out clients with "Overdue invoices" or "Clients with overdue balances", etc.
- You can set Group rates for the work your employees do on a particular



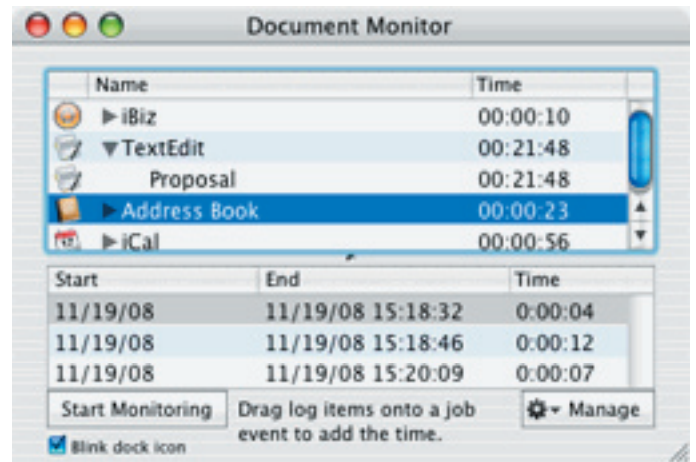
A pie chart shows you your earnings and time per client.

job. For example you can set that Joe (an apprentice carpenter) gets \$7/ hour for the work he does, but Tom (a master carpenter) gets \$75 per hour for his work on the same project.

- A Document Monitor lets you track the time you spend in specific documents. So every time you open that particular document, iBiz starts tracking the time you spend using it and then bills your client for the time spent. This is very handy if you are doing computer work such as accounting, video editing, Web design, etc. since iBiz recognize not only the application used, but also the actual file or document that is opened, it makes it easier to keep the work done for one client separate from another.

- An iBiz Widget (for quick entry of information) and the iBiz Quick Pick (to be used with MobleMe or apple Backup) are also available for download from the IGG Software web site.

There is a "Reports" button that lets you view summery information about your clients, projects and job events. One of the reports options is to view a pie chart that lists the earnings and time per client. This lets you compare project earnings, see how your time is distributed between job events, or prepare statements for your accountant. 🍏
